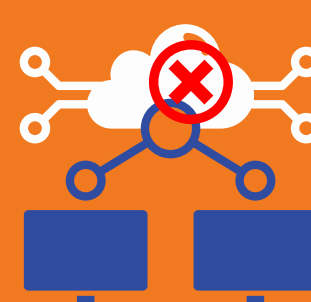

Supported by CS-SUNN under the PINNS 2.0 Project

Transitioned from hard copy to a digital tool piloted in 5+ states

Scaled nationally with support from UNICEF, Alive & Thrive and partners

Iteratively upgraded based on user feedback from multiple states


